## 3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

### Swallowing

May cause abdominal discomfort, nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.

## Eye Exposure

## 5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

### Extinguishing Media

Liquid foam. Dry chemical powder, carbon dioxide or dry chemical media for small fires.

### Extinguishing Media to Avoid

Water in a jet.

### Special Protective Equipment for Fire-fighters

Full protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus.

## 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

### Personal Precautions

Avoid contact with eyes and excessive contact with skin. Ventilate contaminated area thoroughly. A self-contained breathing apparatus is recommended in case of a major spill.

### Spillage

Remove ignition sources. Gross spillage should be contained immediately by use of sand or inert powder and disposed of according to local regulations.

### Environmental Precautions

Prevent contamination of soil and waterways. Flush to sewer and if necessary inform treatment plant operator.

Avoid contact with eyes.
